The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course prepares students with knowledge and skills to provide basic level emergency care in a pre-hospital setting. This course is aligned with the National Education Standards for EMT as approved by the PA DOH (Pennsylvania Department of Health).

- Must be 16 years of age at the start of class
- Must complete the mandatory Haz-Mat awareness class (Not required before the start of class)
- Must complete the FEMA independent study course for NIIMS-100 & NIMS-700 (Not required before the start of class)
 Must obtain at their own expense, a physical examination from a physician and blood screenings (PPD, rubella and
- Must obtain, at their own expense, a physical examination from a physician and blood screenings (PPD, rubella and Hepatitis B- antigen and antibodies). Required to begin clinical requirements. (Not required before the start of class)
- Must obtain, at their own expense, the following: Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance (Act 33), Pennsylvania State Police Request for Criminal Records Check (Act 34) and FBI Criminal Background Check (Act 73).
- Must complete 10 patient contacts in approved setting prior to the final course date
- Must be able to meet all requirements for the Functional Position Description for EMT. The course includes classroom sessions, skill labs, and required clinical rotations in hospitals or ambulance services.
